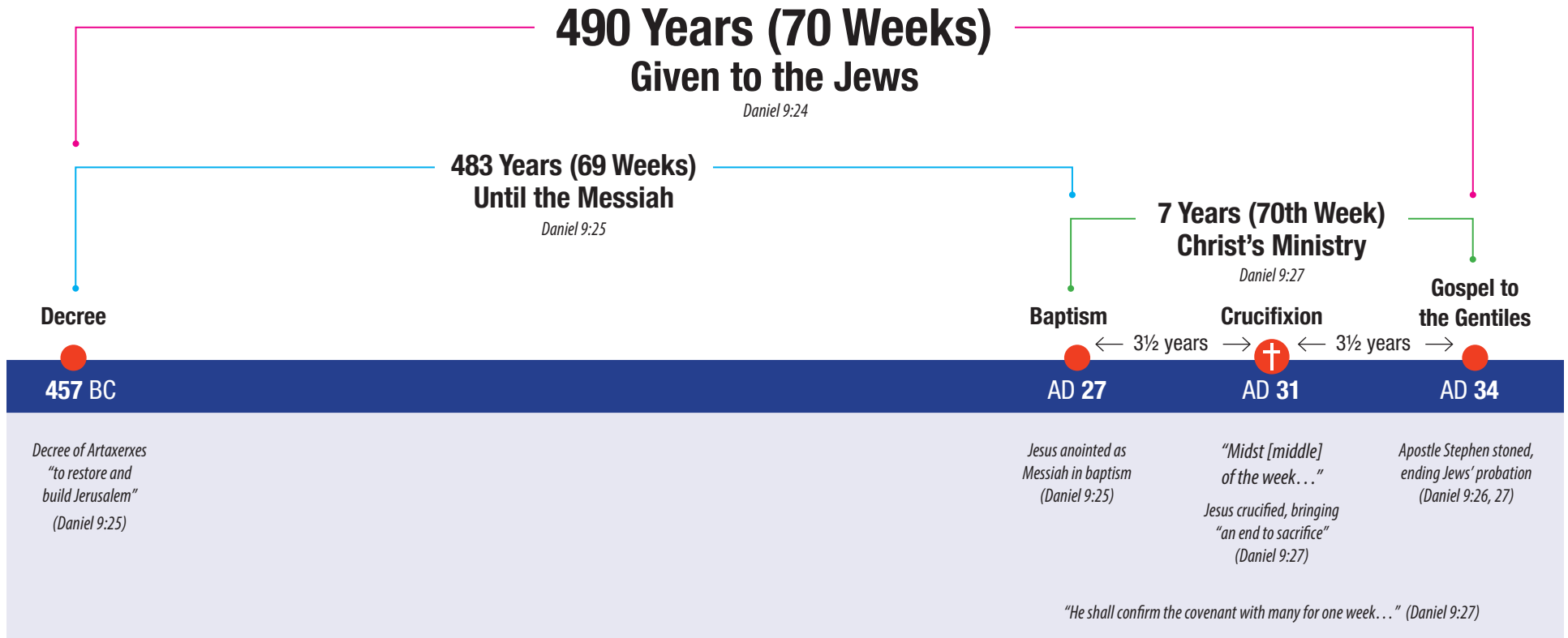


# WHICH WAY, AMERICA?

Night 7 • Part 1  
70 Weeks Chart



## Calculations

**1**

$$\begin{array}{r} 7 \text{ weeks} \\ + 62 \text{ weeks} \\ \hline 69 \text{ weeks} = 483 \text{ Years} \end{array}$$

**2**

$$\begin{array}{r} 70 \text{ weeks} \\ \times 7 \text{ Days} \\ \hline 490 \text{ Days} = 490 \text{ Years} \end{array}$$

Prophetically, 1 day = 1 year (Ezekiel 4:6 and Numbers 14:34).  
So 1 week (7 prophetic days) = 7 literal years, and  
70 prophetic weeks (490 prophetic days) = 490 literal years.

When calculating from BC dates to AD dates, treat the starting BC dates as negative numbers, and add to them.  
Remember to add one year when crossing from BC to AD, because there is no year 0.
